<p>Wednesday 3rd May</p>	<p>Give thanks for St Luke's Toddler Group's long ministry among the Willerby community. Pray that God would bring people from it into church on Sunday.</p>
<p>Thursday 4th May</p>	<p>The Christianity Explored group meets at St Andrew's tonight. Pray that all those who attend would grow in their knowledge and understanding of the gospel.</p>
<p>Friday 5th May</p>	<p>Pray for Faith on Friday that meets over lunch at St Andrew's today, that the ladies who attend would encounter Jesus and grow in their friendship with one another. Give thanks that more children have joined Rockets over the past few months. Pray that those who are not yet Christians would put their trust in Jesus.</p>

<p>Monday 8th May</p>	<p>Pray for Jonathan Hill and the team at St Martin's as they run the Hub on Tuesdays providing a community shop, food parcels, prayer, Bibles and counsel to those in need. Pray for a project manager to oversee some necessary building works.</p>

Pray that they would continue to worship God more and more as they use the gifts he has given them.
Tuesday 16th May	Give thanks for the many new families with young babies who have joined Little Stars over the past few weeks. Pray that they would settle in well and become regulars.
Wednesday 17th May	Give thanks for the leaders and helpers at St Luke's Toddler Group . Pray that they would find much encouragement today in their ministry.
Thursday 18th May	Give thanks for the GAFCON movement of global Anglicans, representing over 75% of Anglicans. Pray that they would
