Prayer Diary – June 2024

Saturday 1 June	Pray that God would add one individual, couple, or family to each of our churches this month.

Wednesday 5 June	Give thanks that the midweek BCP communion service at St Andrew's provides an opportunity for those who come to be fed by God's word during the week.

Friday 7 June	Give thanks for Faith on Friday, which takes place at St Andrew's. Pray that it would be a source of encouragement to those who attend.

Friday 14 June	Give thanks for those who lead and help at our various children's and youth groups. Pray that God would raise up more leaders and helpers.
Saturday 15 June	Pray that God will guide all those entrusted with making decisions in the current deliberations within the Church of England. Pray the eventual outcome will bring glory to God.
Sunday 16 June	We come to God today in great need of his grace. Pray that God would use the Word, prayer, the sacrament, and our Loved by Jesus, Living for Jesus heartfelt praise to build us up and equip us for his service in the week ahead.
Monday 17 June	Pray for St Andrew's PCC to make good gospel centred decisions as they meet tonight.
Tuesday 18 June	Pray for the Men's coffee morning jolly meeting this morning. Pray for gospel centred conversations.
Wednesday 19 June	Give thanks for the many churches in West Hull and the Villages who are committed to a faithful Bible teaching ministry and who meet for West Hull Prayer each Wednesday morning.
Thursday 20 June	The Bishop of Ebbsfleet is coming to St Andrew's today as part of his roadshow. Pray that this would be a useful event for all those who attend.
Friday 21 June	Give thanks for those who make the churches look beautiful with flowers, and for those who keep our various buildings clean and in good repair.

Saturday 22 June	Pray for members of the church families who can't get out to church, that God would sustain them in their faith and provide for their needs. Pray that we are able to support them appropriately.
Sunday 23 June	Pray that our public worship would honour God's name and be attractive to newcomers as we express our delight in and dependence on Jesus Christ.
Monday 24 June	Give thanks for our staff team, both those who work 'up front' and those who work behind the scenes. Pray that they would all find joy in their work.
Tuesday 25 June	Praise God for the ministry of Friendly Community Spaces at St Luke's each Tuesday. Pray that Christians who attend would be intentional about praying for and taking opportunities to share the gospel with non-Christians who also attend.
Wednesday 26 June	Growth Groups meet this week. Pray that God would teach members deeply from his Word.
Thursday 27 June	Give thanks for the new people God has brought to both St Andrew's and St Luke's since last summer.
Friday 28 June	Pray that Friendship Club would be a source of genuine, Christ centred friendships this afternoon.
Saturday 29 June	Pray for those in our church families who are poorly at the moment, that God would strengthen them in their faith and would bring healing.
