## Prayer Diary – November 2024

<b>Friday 1<sup>st</sup> November</b>	Give thanks for all those who came to the various <b>Halloween outreach events</b> and pray that children and families would think about the claims of Jesus, the Light. Pray that many ladies would attend <b>Faith on Friday</b> and be fed spiritually alongside their lunch.
<b>Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> November</b>	Pray that many come to <b>Bangers and Bonfire</b> and that everyone has a fun and safe time in St Andrew's Churchyard. Pray that lots of youth stay for their <b>movie night</b> in the church building.
<b>Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> November</b>	Today is an <b>all-age service</b> in the morning when we will be thinking about <i>the communion of the saints</i> . Give thanks for generations of believers who have gone ahead of us. Give thanks that God has brought to us new members of the <b>Sunday evening</b> congregation.
<b>Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Pray for all those in our churches <b>planning and preparing for Christmas events and services</b> . Pray that their prep would run smoothly and whatever they prepare would lead to many hearing the good news of Jesus.
<b>Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Pray that community would continue to grow at both <b>Friendly Community Space</b> and <b>Little Stars</b> and that it would be increasingly common to speak about Christian things at each. We meet to pray at our <b>Monthly Prayer Evening</b> at 7:45 for 8pm at the Memorial Hall. Pray that we would be praying churches with many from both St Andrew's and St Luke's eager to gather to pray.
<b>Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Pray for growing, gospel shaped friendships at <b>St Luke's Toddler Group</b> . Give thanks for <b>Christianity Explored</b> , and pray for continued fruitful discussions tonight.

<b>Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Praise God for growth at <b>LaunchPad, Rockets and Impact</b> so far this school year. Pray that all those attending would all put their trust in Jesus and grow in their love for him.
<b>Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Give thanks for the <b>resources</b> God has given to us at St Andrew's and St Luke's. Pray that we would all respond to the grace Jesus has shown us by sacrificially giving our money, time and skills for the growth of God's Kingdom here in Willerby, Kirk Ella and beyond.
<b>Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Today is <b>Remembrance Sunday</b> . Pray that any visitors to church would be struck by the gospel even more than by the acts of service of our servicemen and women.
<b>Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November</b>	The <b>Bible Storytelling team</b> are in St Andrew's School this morning. Pray for good engagement with the children. <b>St Andrew's School</b> will visit St Andrew's Churchyard for Remembrance Day. Pray for good chats with parents and teachers for church staff and volunteers.
<b>Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November</b>	<b>Growth Groups</b> meet tonight, tomorrow and Thursday. Pray that members would continue to encounter Jesus in Luke's Gospel.
<b>Weds 13<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Give thanks that the <b>Midweek Communion Service</b> at St Andrew's <b>provides spiritual sustenance for all those who come. Pray that God would continue to bring new people to it.</b>
<b>Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Pray for good conversations at <b>Pub Night</b> at the Wheatsheaf this evening.
<b>Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Give thanks for the partnership in the Gospel <b>expressed between churches at Impact through youth coming from Anlaby Churches, and youth and leaders coming from Barton Evangelical Church.</b>
<b>Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Praise God for the unity in the gospel we share with other <b>Hull Ministry Association</b> churches (All Saints North Ferriby, the Anlaby Churches, St Martin's, St Columba's Drypool, St

	Aiden's Southcoates Avenue, and St John's Bransholme). Praise God too for <b>West Hull Prayer</b> where we gather weekly with people from many CofE churches as well as Christ Church Hessele and Kingston Evangelical.
<b>Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> November</b>	"Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs" (Psalm 100:1-2). Pray that each of us would <b>encounter the living God</b> in worship today, and find our joy in him.
<b>Monday 18<sup>th</sup> November</b>	The <b>Bible Storytelling</b> team are in St Andrew's School today and Carr Lane on Thursday. Pray that some of the children would want to find out more about Jesus and join our Friday groups or come to church. Pray for the growth of ministry as <b>St Luke's PCC</b> meet this evening.
<b>Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Pray that friendships between men would develop and deepen through the <b>Men's Coffee Morning Jolly</b> at Drewton's this morning. Pray that parents and grandparents would find <b>Little Stars</b> and fit into the community there quickly.
<b>Weds 20<sup>th</sup> November</b>	Pray that the leaders and helpers at <b>St Luke's Toddler Group</b> would have the energy they need to run the group today. Pray that group members would find answers to questions they have at <b>Christianity Explored</b> this evening.
